The EnergyPLAN computer model is a freeware, which can be downloaded from the internet. Since the first version was presented in 1999, the EnergyPLAN model has been developed and applied to various cases. It has now been downloaded by more than 500 users from 50 different countries; including most of Europe as well as Australia, Canada, Chile, China, Cuba, India, Iran, Japan, New Zealand, Nicaragua, South Africa and Zimbabwe, among others.
